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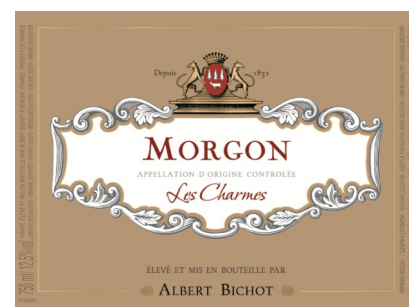
## BEAUJOLAIS CRUS 2014

### Albert Bichot 2014 Morgon Les Charmes

**Drinking window: 2017 - 2021**

90 pts

Deep ruby. Powerful aromas of cherry and raspberry liqueur are joined by vanilla and succulent herb nuances that build in the glass. Round, fleshy and appealingly sweet, offering juicy red fruit flavors that show very good depth as well as energy. The vanilla quality repeats on a long, smooth finish given shape by soft, even tannins.



### Albert Bichot 2014 Domaine de Rochegrès Moulin-à-Vent

**Drinking window: 2017 - 2021**

89 pts

Vivid ruby-red. Spicy and energetic on the nose, displaying zesty red berry and succulent herb qualities and a touch of vanilla. Silky and focused in the mouth, offering lively raspberry and bitter cherry flavors sweetened by the vanilla nuance. Shows good energy and lift on the finish, leaving behind oak spice and vaguely jammy red berry notes.



### Albert Bichot 2014 Fleurie La Madone

**Drinking window: 2018 - 2022**

89 pts

Bright ruby. On the wild side, displaying primary red berry and peppery spice scents and a suggestion of smoked meat. Then juicy and focused on the palate, offering youthfully taut red currant and bitter cherry flavors and a touch of medicinal bitterness. Closes nervy and tight, showing good persistence and lingering spiciness. Give this one some time or at the very least a little air.
